Hy-Khang Dang is one of the most versatile musicians of his generation. He currently works as a composer and appears both as a performer and a conductor. He completed his studies in saxophone, orchestral conducting and composition at the Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel, at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique et de Danse de Paris and at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama whilst being on a Leverhulme Arts Scholarship.

His works have been performed by various ensembles, including Luxembourg Philharmonic Orchestra and Luxembourg Chamber Orchestra in collaboration with eminent conductors such as Duncan Ward, Marie Jacquot and Chloé Dufresne. His most recent compositions have been performed by EXAUDI, Plus-Minus Ensemble and London Contemporary Dance School.

He is currently a **London Symphony Orchestra Soundhub Associate** (2023–26) and a **Britten-Pears Young Artist** (2024–25). He is working on a recent commission for the **Luxembourg Philharmonic Academy** and **United Instruments of Lucilin**, as well as working on an orchestral piece for the **76**<sup>th</sup> **Aldeburgh Festival** and a new piece for the **Neue Vocalsolisten Stuttgart** as part of the **Académie Voix Nouvelles** and **Festival Royaumont**.

As chair of the **Luxembourg Saxophone Association**, he is committed to provide an essential platform for students and teachers, as well as amateur and professional saxophonists through multiple projects and activities across the country.
